Overview



A century ago, Exmoor, Oak Park, and other leaders of golf in Illinois were at the vanguard of establishing a golfing institution – the Illinois Seniors Golf Association, which was founded in July 1923.

Prominent attorney and Exmoor member Silas Strawn drew up bylaws setting forth its mission: to conduct an annual golf tournament to promote golf and friendship among statewide golfers aged 50 and older. Organized by the many founders of the Western Golf Association and the Chicago District Golf Association, the ISGA began and has continued as a celebration of the game of golf itself.

Most current ISGA members are, or have been, leaders at their clubs and/or CDGA Board members, and strong supporters of the WGA and its wonderful Evans Scholar Program. They are an amazing collective human resource, of which we are very proud.

The ISGA holds two golf events yearly, to enjoy golf, renew inter-club friendships, and socialize. Its current membership is about 200, with members from 60+ clubs. These ISGA events are very different from league play or golf outings, because of the shared interest and efforts of its members to improve golf and its impact in Illinois.

Two Centennial Celebrations

This fall, Exmoor will host the 100th Fall Tournament. The first Fall Tournament was held in September 1923. It was so successful that the ISGA decided to also host a Spring Tournament.

Next summer, Oak Park (which hosted the first Fall Championship Tournament), will host the 100th Spring Tournament.

Nearly 50 clubs have hosted ISGA tournaments, because they support the efforts of ISGA and its members regarding golf excellence in greater Chicagoland. Representative ISGA hosts in recent years include Beverly, Edgewood Valley, Elgin, Exmoor, Flossmoor, Glen View, Inverness, Knollwood, Lake Shore, Medinah, Midlothian, Northmoor, North Shore, Oak Park, Olympia Fields, Onwentsia, Park Ridge, Ridgemoor, Skokie and St. Charles.

We are tremendously grateful to Exmoor and Oak Park, and to all the other ISGA tournament hosts, for their support of the ISGA's valuable, long-standing contribution to golf.

Chick Evans and the ISGA



Charles "Chick" Evans Jr. stands among the finest American golfers. An Exmoor member beginning in 1909, he was the first to win the U.S. Open and the U.S. Amateur in one year (1916). Evans won the U.S.

Amateur again in 1920, finished runner-up three times, and competed in 50 consecutive U.S. Amateurs.

He claimed an amazing eight Western Amateurs. His victory in the Western Open as an amateur was a feat not accomplished by anyone else for 75 years. He learned to caddy at Chicago's Edgewater Club. He was also a member at the Glen View Club.

His most lasting achievement was establishing the Evans Scholars Foundation in 1930. More than 11,550 young men and women have

graduated from college as Evans scholars, and 1,070 are presently enrolled in 21 leading universities nationwide.

A member of the World Golf Hall of Fame, Evans received the Bobby Jones Award in 1960, the highest honor given by the United States Golf Association, in recognition of his distinguished sportsmanship in golf.

Evans turned 50 in 1940, and immediately joined the ISGA. He was an active ISGA member for the next 40 years.

ISGA's Contribution to Golf

Exmoor has had a longstanding relationship with organized golf. It is a Founding Member of, and active participant in, the ISGA, CDGA, and WGA.

The first ISGA President was Exmoor member Alexander Revell. The other founding ISGA Directors included Exmoor members Irving Hartz, Ward Willits, Leroy Goddard, and Rufus Abbott. Twenty-six of Exmoor's sixty-two Presidents have been ISGA members. Nine Exmoor members have served as an ISGA President.

Two Exmoor members were CDGA Presidents. Both were ISGA members. Six Exmoor members were WGA Presidents. Five of these were ISGA members. Twelve current Exmoor members serve as WGA Directors.

Oak Park and many other Illinois clubs have a similar legacy.

This multi-organizational involvement of clubs, and their members, and organized golf is very beneficial. The ISGA is proud of its demonstrated ability to support golf in Illinois.
